There are four (4) safety components which are required prior to the safety review of your prequalification package.

Prequalification packages will be placed on hold if these items have not been included.

1. Safety Manual
2. OSHA Form 300A for 3 years
3. OSHA violation(s) explanation
4. Experience Modification Rate (EMR) for 3 years

1. SAFETY MANUAL must cover the following:

**GENERAL COMPANY SAFETY POLICY
HAZARD COMMUNICATIONS
EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN
ELECTRICAL SAFETY
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)**

FALL PROTECTION - if applicable
EXCAVATION – if applicable

2.) OSHA 300A (RECORD KEEPING REQUIREMENTS)

All subcontractors employing 10 or more persons (including temporary help) are required to complete OSHA forms 300 (Log of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses), 301 (Injury and Illness Incident Report) and 300A (Summary of Work- Related Injuries and Illnesses) on a yearly basis. This rule applies even if the subcontractor has zero Work Related Injuries or Illnesses.

OSHA Form 300A (Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses)
Please provide completed copies of the OSHA 300A Form for the most recent three years of business.

3.) OSHA VIOLATIONS If OSHA violations have occurred in any of the most recent three years of business please provide a detailed explanation of what happened in each individual incident and what your firm has done or is doing to eliminate or decrease these incidents.

4.) EMR (Experience Modification Rate) Please provide your EMR for the most recent three years of business. The accepted value at MYC is less than 1.0. If this value is more than 1.0, please provide a detailed written explanation of the reason and what your firm is/has done to decrease your rate.
